Good Health Tips

- **1. Don't eat or touch your face if your hands are dirty. Wash first!**
- **2. Wash any fruits or vegetables with clean water before eating.**
- **3. If you need to sneeze/cough then do it in a tissue or in your elbow to avoid spreading germs.**
- **4. If someone is sick keep a safe distance. Avoid touching or sharing any food or drinks with them.**
- **5. Exercising, eating healthy, and getting a good night's sleep is good for your immune system!**
- **6. Getting a flu shot can help prevent you from getting the flu.**

What To Do If You Get Sick

- ☐ **Stay at home and get rest.**
- ☐ **Drink lots of fluids to stay hydrated. Don't forget to eat.**
- ☐ **Keep a safe distance from other people. Avoid sharing items.**
- ☐ **Cover your mouth when you sneeze or cough.**
- ☐ **If you feel really bad go to a doctor or the hospital.**

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.

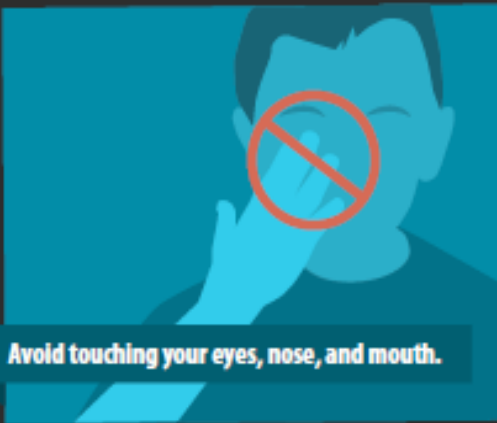
Avoid close contact with people who are sick.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.



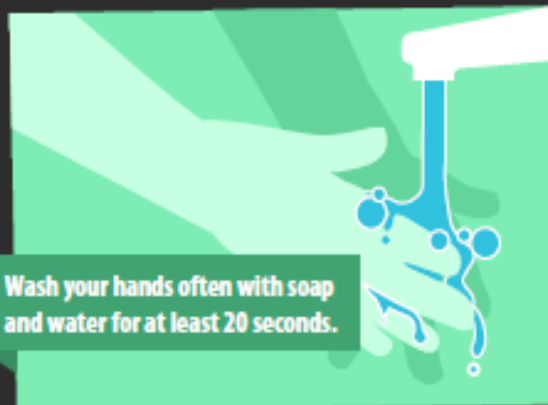
Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
